Petitioner is aggrieved by the action of the respondents in filling up the post of Lambardar whereas the appeal filed by the petitioner against order of dismissal is pending before the Commissioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that purpose of filing appeal would be frustrated in case the post is filled up before decision of the petition.

Heard.

Petitioner was dismissed from the post of Lambardar and against that order, appeal is pending for 05.04.2018 before the Commissioner. Vide order dated 06.02.2018, it has been directed by learned Collector, Ferozepur that post of Lambardar be filled up within a period of 30 days on receipt of orders by inviting applications from the eligible candidates.

No direction can be issued to restrain the respondents to fill up the post. However, in case appointment is made on the post of Lambardar, the same shall be subject to outcome of the appeal filed by the petitioner. The Commissioner is also directed to make all efforts to decide the appeal of the petitioner, preferably within a period of four weeks.
