JASPAL SINGH, J

Through instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent authorities to grant the deemed date of regularization to the petitioner to the post of Helper Grade-I w.e.f 05.09.1991 the date when juniors were granted the benefit and release the arrears thereof together with interest @ 18% per annum.

2. At the very outset of the arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner feels satisfied, in case, direction is issued to respondents to consider legal notice dated 19.12.2017 (Annexure P-6), within some prescribed period.

3. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is disposed of with the direction to respondents to consider the

case of the petitioner as set up by the petitioner in legal notice dated 19.12.2017 (Annexure P-6) and to take a conscious decision in accordance with law, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. However, if the petitioner still feels dissatisfied against the order passed by the concerned authority, he shall be at liberty to have recourse to the other remedies available under law as well as to approach this Court.
