The present petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for issuance of direction to respondent No.4 to decide the appeal filed by the petitioner under Section 68 of the Punjab Cooperative Societies Act, 1961.

The grievance is that the appeal is pending since 23.12.2015.

From the pleadings in the writ petition, it is not evident that any such request has been made to respondent No.4 for early disposal of the appeal or to decide the application for interim stay filed by the petitioner.

No case to issue any direction to respondent No.4 is made out. The petitioner may make a request to respondent No.4 either for early disposal of the appeal or for passing an order on the application for interim stay.

If such a request is made by the petitioner before respondent No.4, there is no doubt that the same would be dealt with appropriately in accordance with law.

With liberty aforementioned, the writ petition is disposed of.
