This petition is filed for extension in the period of parole for two weeks.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has met with an accident on 28.02.2018 and suffered fractures of 2nd, 3rd and 4th ribs with right foot medial malleolus and talus. He was also operated for fracture of medial malleolus and talus of right ankle and was discharged on 03.03.2018 from Safe Hands Hospital, Gurugram. He was also advised by the Doctor that he should not lift weight for six weeks. It is submitted that a period of four weeks has already been over from the date of his discharge from the hospital. The petitioner has prayed that he may be allowed extension in parole for a period of two weeks.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has already undergone six years sentence and has been on parole in the past also. It is also submitted that he has surrendered to the jail authorities after the expiry of the period of parole.

Learned State counsel has submitted that the petitioner has already availed the benefit of parole of four weeks, therefore, he does not deserve extension of two more weeks as prayed for.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties and considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, I am of the considered opinion that the petitioner deserves extension in period of parole in view of the certificate issued by the Doctor who had operated upon him. The very fact that the petitioner has been on parole in the past and surrendered in time also supports his case.

Thus, in view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the present petition is hereby allowed and extension in parole for two weeks is granted to the petitioner which shall be extended from today i.e. 02.04.2018 on the same bail bonds, furnished by the petitioner, at the time parole was granted to him.
