In the nature of order I propose to pass, no formal written
statement(s)/counter-affidavit(s) on behalf of the respondents are indeed
necessary at this stage. Thus, with the consent of the learned counsel for the
parties, the petition is being disposed of finally.

The petitioner competed for selection to the post of Heavy
Vehicle Driver, pursuant to an advertisement dated 18.5.2017 (Annexure P-
1) in the BC-A Category. He purports to have qualified the written
examination as also the driving proficiency test, whereafter, he was even
called for scrutiny of documents. The limited grievance that he has is; that
in the list of short-listed candidates, who were called for

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interview, his name and roll number was not depicted. Concededly, the process of selection has been concluded, and even the results have since been pronounced on 3.3.2018. It is urged that as per self assessed OMR sheet, and the answer key, uploaded by the Commission on its website, the petitioner had obtained 120 marks, whereas the last candidate, in his category, who had obtained merely 80 marks, was called for interview or perhaps even been selected. But, for some intangible reason, the claim of the petitioner has been ignored.

In response, learned State counsel submits that claim/grievance of the petitioner shall be considered and dealt with by the respondents within a period of two weeks from today. And appropriate orders, in accordance with law, shall be passed.

The petition is accordingly disposed of, in the above terms. In the event, the claim of the petitioner is declined, the authority shall pass a comprehensive order assigning reasons in support thereof.
