On 15.11.2017, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Since writ petition is not maintainable having regard to the grievance of the petitioner, it is made clear that on the fixed date, if there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner, matter would be decided on the ground of maintainability.

With the above observation, civil miscellaneous application stands disposed of.”

Grievance relating to the petitioner lies before the Central Administrative Tribunal. Therefore, petition is not maintainable.

Accordingly, petition stands dismissed. Reserving liberty to the petitioner to approach appropriate forum in accordance with law.
