Through instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioners have sought issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondents to extend the benefit of refixation of pay/pension of the petitioners w.e.f. 01.04.1979 as has been done in the case of the petitioners in CWP No.16084 of 1997 captioned as *Dharam Pal Singh vs. State of Haryana & ors.* and CWP No.2757 of 1998, titled as *Diwan Chand & ors. vs. State of Haryana*, decided on July 27, 2000 by this Court in terms of CWP No.13300 of 1990 with all consequential benefits.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that though representation dated 09.12.2017 (P-7) was duly served upon the

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respondents but till date no conscious decision has been taken. He further submits that petitioners feel satisfied in case direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide aforesaid representation, within some prescribed period.

3. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2-The Director, Primary Education, Forest Building, Sector 17, Chandigarh to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioners in the representation dated 09.12.2017 (P-7) and to decide the same as per Rules and in the light of judgments referred to above in para no.1 of this order, within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case of non compliance of this order, petitioners shall be at liberty to have recourse to the other remedies available to them as well as to approach this Court.
