In the nature of order I propose to pass, no formal written
statement(s)/counter-affidavit(s) on behalf of the respondents are indeed
necessary at this stage. Thus, with the consent of the learned counsel for the
parties, the petition is being disposed of finally.

The petitioner competed for selection to the post of Heavy
Vehicle Driver, in response to the advertisement dated 18.5.2017 (Annexure
P-1), in the General Category. He purports to have qualified the written
examination as also the driving proficiency test. However, in the list of
short-listed candidates, who were called for interview in his category, the

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name and roll number of the petitioner was not depicted. The final results have since been pronounced by the Commission on 3.3.2018 (Annexure P-5). The limited grievance that the petitioner has is; that the last candidate, who has been selected in the General Category, had obtained 129 marks, whereas, as per the self assessed OMR sheet and the answer key uploaded by the Commission on its website, the petitioner had secured 130 marks. Thus, he submits that for some intangible reason, claim of the petitioner was still ignored.

In response, learned counsel for the respondents submits that claim/grievance of the petitioner shall be considered and dealt with within a period of two weeks from today. And appropriate orders, in accordance with law, shall be passed and communicated to the petitioner as also to his counsel.

The petition is accordingly disposed of, in the above terms. In the event, the claim of the petitioner is declined, the authority shall pass a comprehensive order assigning reasons in support thereof.
