Mr. R.K. Doon, AAG, Haryana, present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Copies supplied.

In the nature of order I propose to pass, no formal written statement(s)/counter-affidavit(s) on behalf of the respondents are indeed necessary at this stage. Thus, with the consent of the learned counsel for the parties, the petition is being disposed of finally.

The petitioner is aggrieved by her transfer to Government Girls Senior Secondary School, Kahanaur, Block Kalanaur, District Rohtak. Ex facie, the impugned order was passed over six months ago, and the petitioner has even joined, in compliance thereof, at her new place of posting. Even otherwise, she had served at her previous posting for nearly three years, before she was transferred, vide impugned order dated 3.8.2017. However, it is urged that the petitioner is orthopaedically handicapped, for she suffers from 70% permanent disability. And, post her transfer, she purports to have repeatedly represented to the respondents to review the impugned order or she be assigned some convenient posting, as her current posting falls in the 7th zone.

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In response, learned State counsel submits that claim/grievance of the petitioner as also her representation, dated 8.8.2017 (Annexure P-5), shall be considered and dealt with by the respondents within a period of four weeks from today. And appropriate orders, in accordance with law, shall be passed.

The petition is accordingly disposed of, in the above terms. In the event, claim of the petitioner is declined, the respondent authorities shall pass a comprehensive order, assigning reasons in support thereof.
