This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a writ, in the nature of mandamus directing respondent Nos.1 and 2 to consider the claim of the petitioner for the post of Social Science Mistress.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.3- Director, Education Recruitment Board-cum-Director General School Education Department, Punjab, Govt.Modal Senior Secondary School, Phase-3B-1, SAS Nagar, Mohali to consider and decide the representation dated 01.02.2018 (Annexure P-4).

Heard.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3- Director, Education Recruitment Board-cum-Director General School

Education Department, Punjab, Govt.Modal Senior Secondary School, Phase-3B-1, SAS Nagar, Mohali to consider and decide the representation 01.02.2018 (Annexure P-4) within six weeks from the receipt of the certified copy of the order. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to her, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to her, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible to her or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
