Mr. R.K.Doon, AAG, Haryana, present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Copy furnished.

In the nature of order I propose to pass in the matter, no formal written statement(s)/counter affidavit(s), on behalf of the respondents, is indeed necessary, at this stage. Thus, with the consent of learned counsel for the parties the petition is being disposed of finally.

The petitioners are employed as part time Sweepers with the respondents-department since 2003. Vide this petition, they pray for a direction to the respondents to consider their claims for regularization of their services, in terms of the instructions dated 30.12.1998/25.02.1999 (Annexure P-2). Particularly, as the services of those, who were identically placed and circumstanced, as petitioners, have since been regularized,

pursuant to an order dated 11.03.2011 and 25.07.2011 (Annexures P-6 and P-7), respectively. The petitioners purports to have repeatedly represented to the respondents in this regard. But to no avail. Even the legal notice dated 21.11.2017 (Annexure P-8), the respondents have been served with, has failed to evoke any response.

As to this, learned counsel for the respondents submits that the claim/grievance of the petitioners as also their legal notice dated 21.11.2017 (Annexure P-8), shall be considered and dealt with within a period of three months from today. And, appropriate orders, in accordance with law, shall be passed.

The petition is accordingly, disposed of, in the above terms. However, in the event, the claim of the petitioners is declined, the respondents-authority shall pass a comprehensive order assigning reasons in support thereof.
