Through the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to grant benefit to the petitioner of stepping up of pay at par in general category with private respondent Om Parkash from the date of his promotion to the post of HG-I (in reserve category) and further directions to the respondents to pay all the consequential benefit to the petitioner along with interest 18% per annum from the date of due till its realization.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though the representation dated 23.11.2017 was made to the respondents 'Annexure P-4' but till date neither any reply to the said representation has been received nor any final order has been passed by the respondents.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents to decide his representation dated 23.11.2017 (Annexure P-4) in a time bound manner.

4. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents Nos.1 to 4 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated 23.11.2017 (Annexure P-4) and to take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order considering all the facts narrated in the aforesaid representation within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

5. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the aforesaid authority, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
