Mr. R.K. Doon, AAG., Haryana, present in court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Copies supplied.

In the nature of order I propose to pass, no formal written statement(s)/counter-affidavit(s) on behalf of the respondents are indeed necessary at this stage. Thus, with the consent of the learned counsel for the parties, the petition is being disposed of finally.

The petitioners competed for selection to the post of TGT (Physical Education), in the General Category, and qualified the written examination, that was held on 20.12.2015. However, they did not participate in the scrutiny of documents, for they had not qualified the requisite examination, i.e. HTET. But, the note appended with the eligibility clause in the advertisement (Annexure P-5), at page 30, postulates that even those candidates, who qualified the HTET examination even till the date of interview, shall be permitted to participate in the interview.

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And, for the petitioners qualified the said examination on 1.3.2018, and the interviews are yet to take place, it is urged that they have a right to be considered for selection.

In response, learned State counsel submits that claim/grievance of the petitioners shall be considered and dealt with by the respondents within a period of two weeks from today. And appropriate orders, in accordance with law, shall be passed and communicated to the petitioners as also to their counsel, before the interviews are held.

The petition is accordingly disposed of, in the above terms. In the event, the claim of the petitioners is declined, the authority shall pass a comprehensive order assigning reasons in support thereof.
