By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to count the work charges-service followed by his regularization for the purposes of pensionary benefits with further direction to extend the benefit of judgment as granted to similarly situated employees.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that though various representations including representation dated October 16, 2017 (P-4) were made by the petitioner but till date neither any reply to the said representations has been received nor any conscious decision has been taken. He further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents to consider and decide the afore-said representation (P-4) within a stipulated period.

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation (P-4) and to decide the same in accordance with law, rules, regulations and instructions issued by the Government from time to time as well as in view of judgment passed by this Court in CWP No. 7126 of 2004 (P-1) within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved by any order of the afore-said authorities, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
