JITENDRA CHAUHAN.J.(ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in response to the appointment letter issued by the respondents, the petitioner has joined the respondents. However, he states that the remaining consequential benefits have not been passed on to the petitioner. He further states that he is ready to forgo the monetary benefits provided he is given seniority from the date of initial selection on the basis of his merit.

The Court, at this stage, is not inclined to express anything on the merit of the case. Considering the fact that substantial relief has been granted to the petitioner, the petitioner is at liberty to take up the issue with the respondents and to make a detailed representation to the respondents who shall decide the same within three months from the date of receipt of such an representation.
