Petitioner is aggrieved that during the pendency of the proceedings before the competent authority initially status quo was granted but then discontinued by virtue of the impugned order.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and upon perusal of the impugned order we are of the opinion that issuance of notice of motion to the respondent may not be essential in view of the nature of direction that we propose to pass. We direct that the authority before whom the proceedings are pending shall conclude it within a period of four months and till that time the status quo with regard to the possession shall be maintained.

However, it is made clear that no untoward adjournment shall

be given to either of the parties.
