By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned action of the respondents for not giving relaxation of Rule 6.24 (7) of Punjab Civil Service Rules, Vol. II for the purpose of revising pension to her w.e.f. 01.11.2007, on account of her notional pay fixation in the revised pay scale of Rs.7500/--12000/- w.e.f. 01.01.1996 as per order dated 18.08.2017 (P-4) with further direction for the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to revise her pension w.e.f. 01.11.2017, on the basis of re-fixation of her pay in the revised pay scale of Rs. 7500/--12000/- w.e.f. 01.01.1996 and onwards in furtherance to the letter dated 25.03.2015 (P-3) and also to grant her due arrear of pension along-with interest @ 12% p.a. from due date till its realization.

2. At the very outset learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents No. 2 to decide the representation dated 08.01.2018 (P-6) made by the petitioner, within some stipulated period.

3. In view of submission made by learned counsel for the petitioner but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in her representation dated 08.01.2018 (P-6) in accordance with law, rules and regulations, within a period of three months from the date of receipts of certified copy of this order.

4. However, in case the petitioner feels dissatisfied by any inaction of the authorities concerned, she shall be at liberty to have recourse to the other remedies available under the law, including to approach this Court.
