By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to count his previous services rendered by him w.e.f. April 07, 1983 to March 23, 1988 on daily wages and ad-hoc basis prior to regularization of served and also to release his two annual grade increments for the ad-hoc period as well as to release all the revised pensionary benefits along-with interest.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has contended that a legal notice dated January 30, 2018 (P-6) was served upon the respondents but despite the fact that a period of more than one months has elapsed neither any reply to the afore-said legal notice has been received nor any action has been taken till date.

He further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to

respondents No.2 and 3 to consider and decide the the afore-said legal notice January 30, 2018 (P-6) within some time bound manner.

3. Without expression any opinion on the merits of the case and also in view of submission made by learned counsel for the petitioner, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the legal notice dated January 30, 2018 (P-6) in accordance with law, rules and regulations particularly in view of the judgments reference of which finds mention in the legal notice, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case, petitioner still feels aggrieved by any inaction of the authority, he shall be at liberty to have recourse to the other remedies available under law, including to approach this Court.
