In the present petition, the grievance raised by the petitioners, who are the retired employees of the Government Aided Private Recognized Colleges, is that they should also be extended the benefit of earned leave and the same be credited to their account. The writ petition was filed by placing reliance on the judgment of this Court Annexure P-5 passed in CWP No.12179 of 2011 decided on 10.11.2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that apart from the benefit of earned leave, petitioner No.1 is also entitled for the gratuity, for which a demand has already been raised by her with the respondents.

No reply to the writ petition has been filed by State of Haryana.

Learned counsel for the respondents produced a notification dated 14.08.2018 vide which the Government decided to implement the judgment Annexure P-5 passed in CWP No.12179 of 2011 dated 10.11.2016. It is expected that State Government will implement the notification dated 14.08.2018 at the earliest. In view of the above, the grievance raised by the petitioners stands redressed.

In respect to the claim of gratuity on behalf of petitioner No.1, let petitioner No.1 file a detailed representation in respect of her claim with the respondents within a period of four weeks. After the receipt of the same, the competent authority, to whom the said representation will be addressed, which is to decide the said claim, will pass a speaking order, within the period of next three months. In case, petitioner No.1 is found entitled to the gratuity, the same should also be released to her within a period of next three months.

The writ petition stands disposed of, in view of the above.
