This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a writ, in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to calculate the compensation as claimed by the petitioner to the tune of Rs.2,19,46,649/- along with interest @ 12% per annum till date.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner states that at this stage she would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.2-Claim Commissioner, Home Department Haryana, Haryana Civil Secretariat, Chandigarh to finalise the proceedings pending before him within a stipulated period.

On the other hand, learned State counsel states that he has no objection in case the prayer made by the petitioner is accepted.

Heard.

In view of the above, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to conclude the proceedings expeditiously preferably within four months. Further, learned counsel for the petitioner assures to assist the authorities for the settlement of the claim.
