The petitioner has prayed for the issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the order dated 26.5.2016 passed by the respondents vide which his application for grant of license of retail outlet has been rejected on the ground that as per the policy in the village having Public Health Centre, only three licenses could be granted whereas, as per the report, already six licenses are existing in the village.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that if the respondents can issue more licenses than the prescribed quota, then why not the petitioner be issued the license.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner but not impressed by the arguments raised by him because if the respondents have already committed a mistake by giving more licenses than the required quota, they cannot be directed to commit the mistake further.

Thus, in view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, I do not find any merit in this petition for the purpose of interference.

Dismissed.
