Though the petitioners have today moved an application (CM No.1714 of 2018) to place on record some material but we find that it does not meet all the requirements of the order dated 19.05.2017. Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks and is permitted to withdraw this writ petition with liberty to file a fresh petition on the same cause of action and with better particulars.
