Vide order dated 15.3.2018 on the basis of statement made by learned counsel for the appellants a proposal was made for enhancing compensation by ₹ 3,50,000/- over and above the amount already granted by the MACT concerned. Today, learned counsel for the Insurance Company has stated that the Insurance Company has agreed to enhance the compensation only by ₹ 3,10,000/- and not by ₹ 3,50,000/- and has signed to that effect. Learned counsel for the appellants has agreed to this counter-offer of the respondent-Insurance Company.

Accordingly, ₹ 3,10,000/- (Rs. Three Lakh Ten Thousand only) is allowed as further compensation over and above the compensation already awarded by the MACT. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellants the enhanced amount would be paid to both the appellants in equal share.

We dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit two crossed-cheques in the sum of ₹ 1,55,000/- each 1) in the name of appellant No.1-Ramesh Chand s/o Sh. Hari Ram; 2) in the name of appellant No.2 Asha Rani w/o Sh. Ramesh Chand, with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 1.6.2018 failing which the

amount will carry 9% interest p.a. from the date of this order till the cheques are deposited with the office of the Lok Adalat. The appellants' counsel/appellants may collect the cheques from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order/statement be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the High Court.
