1. The petitioner by way of present petition seeks direction in the nature of Mandamus for the respondents to finalize the provisionally assessed bills of entry in respect of the details mentioned in the headnote of the petition.

2. Upon notice of motion having been issued, learned counsel for respondents submitted that 10 bills of entries out of the 22 have already been finalized. It is further submitted that in respect of the remaining 12 bills of entries the report from the Central Revenue Control Laboratory has been received and the same shall be finalized within a period of two weeks from the date of appearance by the petitioner after affording an opportunity of hearing.

3. After hearing learned counsel for the parties, perusing the present petition and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, we dispose of the present petition by granting liberty to the petitioner to appear before the appropriate authority/respondent no.1 on 28.5.2018,

whereupon the said authority shall pass an order on the 12 bills of entries which have been provisionally assessed earlier within a period of 15 days in accordance with law by passing a speaking order and after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner prayed that petitioner may be granted liberty to take recourse to the remedies as may be available in respect of 10 bills of entries which have already been finalized.

5. It shall be open for the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to it in respect of 10 bills of entries which have already been finalized.
