Mr. R.K. Doon, AAG., Haryana, present in court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Copies supplied.

In the nature of order I propose to pass, no formal written statement(s)/counter-affidavit(s) on behalf of the respondents are indeed necessary at this stage. Thus, with the consent of the learned counsel for the parties, the petition is being disposed of finally.

The petitioner competed for selection to the post of Heavy Vehicle Driver, in response to the advertisement No. 4/2017 (Annexure P-1), in the ESM-BCB Category. He purports to have qualified the written examination as also the driving proficiency test. Whereafter, he was called for scrutiny of documents as also for interview. The limited grievance that he has is: that in the final results pronounced by the Commission on 3.3.2018, the name and roll number of the petitioner was not depicted.

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Whereas, out of 61 posts, that were reserved in the category of the petitioner i.e. ESM-BCB, only 44 candidates were called for interview. Thus, it is urged that there could hardly be any reason to ignore the candidature of the petitioner. And, though the process of selection has since been concluded, but no appointments have still been made.

In response, learned State counsel submits that claim/grievance of the petitioner shall be considered and dealt with within a period of two weeks from today. And appropriate orders, in accordance with law, shall be passed and communicated to the petitioner as also to his counsel.

The petition is accordingly disposed of, in the above terms. In the event, the claim of the petitioner is declined, the authority shall pass a comprehensive order assigning reasons in support thereof.
