1. In the instant writ petition the petitioner has challenged the award passed by the Labour Court on 14.12.2017 (Annexure P-6). No doubt it is an *ex parte* award, however, for the purpose of claiming benefit by the petitioner, he should have filed necessary application to summon the records relating to discharge of duties for the post which has been held by him. Therefore, rightly the Labour Court passed award against the petitioner. No ground is made out for quashing the award.
