Mr. R.K. Doon, AAG., Haryana, present in court, accepts notice on their behalf. Copies supplied.

In the nature of order I propose to pass, no formal written statement(s)/counter-affidavit(s) on behalf of the respondents are indeed necessary at this stage. Thus, with the consent of the learned counsel for the parties, the petition is being disposed of finally.

The petitioner is employed as Associate Professor in the Department of General Surgery with B.P.S. Government Medical College for Women, Khanpur Kalan, District Sonapat (respondent No.3). In response to the advertisement dated 13.1.2018 (Annexure P-2), issued by All India Institute of Medical Sciences, Jodhpur (Rajasthan) [respondent No.4], the petitioner applied for the post of Additional Professor in General Surgery. Vide letter dated 15.3.2018 (Annexure P-4), issued by respondent No.4, the petitioner is required to appear for interview on 25.3.2018, and submit his experience as also the no objection certificate (NOC), failing which, his

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candidature shall not be considered. The limited grievance that the petitioner has is; that even though he applied for the post in question through proper channel, and vide letter dated 8.2.2018 (Annexure P-3), addressed to the Director of the College (respondent No.3), he requested to issue NOC and the experience certificate, but to date, neither his application has been declined/rejected, nor the requisite certificates have been issued. It is urged that the interview is slated to take place on 25.3.2018, and in the given situation, if the necessary documents are not released, the petitioner shall suffer an incalculable loss.

In response, learned State counsel submits that claim/grievance of the petitioner shall be examined and dealt with by 21.3.2018 itself, and in the eventuality of there being no impediment of his not being eligible, he shall be issued the necessary documents, by 22.3.2018.

The petition is accordingly disposed of, in the above terms. In the event, the claim of the petitioner is declined, the respondents shall pass a comprehensive order, assigning reasons in support thereof.
