The petitioner has handed-over a cheque of Rs.1.0 lac to counsel for the respondent-bank in Court. The Branch Manager of the bank is directed to inform the petitioner the overdue amount within one week from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order. The petitioner shall deposit the overdue amount within three weeks thereafter. In case the petitioner deposits the overdue amount, the bank may regularize her account subject to her depositing the future installments on time. However, if she fails to pay the overdue amount, the bank shall be at liberty to proceed against her in accordance with law.

The writ petition stands disposed of in the above-terms.
