This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus while waiving/rechecking of interest/penal interest afresh by quashing the orders dated 30.12.2017 (Annexure P-5) and dated 10.01.2018 (Annexure P-9A).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that a Certificate has been issued by respondent – bank intimating that all the original documents relating to the property mortgaged as a collateral security have been delivered to the party on 04.08.2018 and the Cash Credit Account No.1852050000181 has been closed by way of full and final settlement on 03.08.2018. However, the prayer was made that the petitioner be granted liberty to contest the interest charged by the respondent-bank. The copy of the said Certificate is taken on record.

3. In view of above, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner

to contest the interest, which has been charged by the respondent-bank in accordance with law.
