This appeal (FAO-8959-2014) has arisen from the judgment and decree dated 30.08.2013 passed by the District Judge, Family Court, Ambala, by which petition filed by the appellant-wife under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (hereinafter referred to as 'the Act') for dissolution of the marriage by way of a decree of divorce was dismissed.

During the pendency of this appeal, the parties to the lis have arrived at a settlement on 09.05.2018 and decided to part ways on mutual terms.

On 16.10.2018, parties had come present in the Court and got their statements recorded at the first motion stage. Hearing of the case was deferred for today for recording the statements of the parties at the second motion stage.

Both the parties are present in Court today and their statements

have been recorded separately at second motion stage. We have asked both of them separately as to whether they are still ready and willing to part ways by way of a decree of divorce in terms of the petition filed under Section 13-B of the Act. They have stated that they do not want to live together and are sticking to their statements made at the first motion stage.

Thus, in view thereof, the present petition, filed under Section 13-B of the Act, is hereby allowed and the marriage of the parties which was performed on 14.07.2003 is hereby dissolved by a decree of divorce by mutual consent.
