Petitioner is a permanent resident of Batala. He was recruited as Constable in 82 Battalion of Punjab Armed Police, Chandigarh on 27.04.2004. He was sent on deputation to PSPCL, Patiala on 3.9.2006. He is stated to have been posted at the Anti Power Theft Wing of PSPCL, Verka, Amritsar in the year 2009. By filing the present writ petition, he has impugned the order dated 14.03.2018 whereby he has been repatriated back to his parent unit i.e. 82 Battalion, PAP, Chandigarh.

Counsel for the petitioner heard at length.

It is conceded that ordinarily and statutorily a deputation for an employee allowed is for three years, however, the petitioner has continued to be on deputation from outside his parent unit for a period of more than 11 years. It is further evident that the order of repatriation has been passed in

compliance of the general order passed by the DGP, seeking repatriation of

all the over stay employees on deputation. No legal prejudice has been caused to the petitioner on such repatriation. The said recourse cannot be faulted with. It is also not disputed that the petitioner has no right to stay on deputation forever.

In view of the above, finding no merit in the present writ petition, the same is hereby dismissed.
