13 Petitioners were enrolled as Constables with District Cadre Police in June 2015 pursuant to the selections made vide advertisement dated 11.09.2010 under the 2% reservation for the Wards of “deserving” police personnel, after the decision dated 11.03.2015 passed in CWP No.13493 of 2010 by a learned Single Judge of this Court. The claim is for grant of benefits with effect from the date constables recruited in the same batch with notional benefits. It is stated that the matter is covered by a decision dated 09.08.2017 passed in CWP No.12829 of 2017 (P-5), whereby this Court has directed the DGP/Competent Authority to consider the claim of the petitioners in accordance with law.

Upon notice learned State Counsel on instructions from Mr. Harvinder Singh, Assistant Clerk, ASI Sarjiwan Singh, I/C Civil Suit,

SSP Bathinda, concedes that in a similar petition involving identical issues this Court vide decision dated 9.8.2017 (P-5) has directed the DGP to decide the claim by passing a speaking order.

Learned Counsel accordingly on instructions agrees that the present petition also be disposed of with the direction to the competent Authority to decide the case of the petitioners as set out in their legal notice dated 14.09.2017 (P-4) as also in the present petition by passing a speaking order within four months from the receipt of certified copy of this Order.

Ordered accordingly.
