Prayer in this petition is for quashing of order dated 07.2.2018 (Annexure P-5) passed by respondent No.2 and for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing the respondents not to allot liquor vends in the village of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that as the period, for which the Gram Panchayat, Gram Damla, District Yamuna Nagar (Haryana) had passed resolution for not opening the liquor vend in the village for the year 2018-19, is almost over, he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition. If the Gram Panchayat wishes to pass any resolution for not opening liquor vend in the village for the next year, needful shall be done well within time and the same will be sent to the

competent authority for taking appropriate action well before the allotment of vends take place.
