HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J. (ORAL)

Counsel for the respondents states that the department has considered and found that the petitioner was entitled for a sum of ₹5,24,921/- for which a cheque was prepared on 18.09.2018. The said cheque was offered to the petitioner but he refused. The cheque has been offered to the counsel for the petitioner today and he has accepted the same.

Counsel for the petitioner states that details have not been given as to how the department has arrived upon the said figure. Counsel for the petitioner states that he be given the calculations on the basis of which the department had arrived upon

the said amount.

Counsel for the respondents has supplied the details of the cheque in the Court today, which are handed over to the counsel for the petitioner.

Counsel for the petitioner prays that he be given opportunity to file a representation in case any other amount is due on/of any other account. The said liberty is granted. In case the petitioner feels that he is entitled for some other amount apart from the calculated amount, he may file the representation with the respondents within next three weeks. In case any representation is filed, the respondents are directed to consider the same and pass an appropriate order on the said claims being made within the next period of three months.

The writ petition stands disposed of.
