Notice of motion, confined to respondents No. 1 to 3 only, at this stage.

Mr. R.K. Doon, AAG., Haryana, present in court, accepts notice on their behalf. Copies supplied.

In the nature of order I propose to pass, no formal written statement(s)/counter-affidavit(s) on behalf of the respondents are indeed necessary at this stage. Thus, with the consent of the learned counsel for the parties, the petition is being disposed of finally.

The petitioner competed for selection to the post of Statistical Assistant, in response to the advertisement dated 10.7.2015 (Annexure P-4), in the BCA-Dependent of Freedom Fighter Category. He qualified the written examination, but was not called for interview. Resultantly, he approached this Court vide CWP No. 11001 of 2017, and pursuant to an interim order, dated 31.5.2017, he was required to be interviewed provisionally. However, as per the final results pronounced by the Commission, the last candidate in the category of the petitioner, (BC-A), had obtained 145 marks, whereas, the petitioner had secured merely 100 marks.

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Resultantly, the petition was disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous, though he was granted liberty to pursue his claim; being a dependent of freedom fighter. It is urged that immediately thereafter, vide representation dated 12.12.2017 (Annexure P-12), the petitioner required the respondents to consider his claim, in the said category, particularly, in terms of Note.3 of the advertisement (at page 37 of the paper book); that entitled him therefor. Another representation dated 9.1.2018 (Annexure P-13), the respondents have been served with, too has failed to evoke any response.

Learned State counsel submits that claim/grievance of the petitioner as also his representation, dated 9.1.2018 (Annexure P-13), shall be considered and decided within a period of four weeks from today. And appropriate orders, in accordance with law, shall be passed.

The petition is accordingly disposed of, in the above terms. In the event, the claim of the petitioner is declined, the authority shall pass a comprehensive order assigning reasons in support thereof.
