Mr. RK Doon, AAG, Haryana, present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Copies furnished.

For the nature of order I propose to pass in the matter, no formal written statements/counter affidavits on behalf of the respondents are indeed necessary, at this stage. Thus, with the consent of the parties, the petition is being disposed of finally.

The petitioner claims medical reimbursement of his bills (Annexure P1 Colly.) that were furnished to the respondent-department as back as on 01.09.2016. It is urged that although a considerable time has elapsed, but the matter continues to await consideration of the competent authority, and as a result the petitioner has been subjected to an avoidable financial hardship.

In response, learned State counsel submits that the claim/grievance of the petitioner shall be considered and dealt with within a period of four weeks from today. And appropriate orders, in accordance with

law, shall be passed. Further, in the absence of any impediment as regards entitlement of the petitioner, the requisite amount shall be released at the earliest.

The petition is accordingly disposed of in the above terms.

However, in the event the claim of the petitioner is declined, the respondent-authorities shall pass a comprehensive order assigning reasons in support thereof.
