The Petitioner was working as a Watchman/Deployed as Salesman in the Markfed Branch of Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur. Punishment order dated 29.03.2016 (P-3) and the consequent recovery order dated 7.9.2016 (P-4) came about to be passed whereby the punishment of “Stoppage of Two Annual Increments with cumulative effect” was imposed on conclusion of the disciplinary proceedings for imposition of major penalty and the consequent recovery for 50% of the amount of Rs.37,15,425/- was imposed. The petitioner filed statutory appeal.

Although by filing the present petition apart from seeking quashing of the aforesaid orders P-3 & P-4 other reliefs like refixation of pay and promotion w.e.f. the date his juniors were promoted were also

prayed for. However, this Court vide order dated 10.05.2017 issued notice only qua the non deciding of the statutory appeal by the Appellate Authority since last more than one year.

At the time of hearing, it is conceded that the Appellate Authority has since dismissed the appeal vide order dated 10.08.2017 (P-6).

Consequently CM No.1325 of 2018 has been filed by the petitioner seeking permission of this Court to amend the petition so as to challenge the Appellate order as well. Keeping in view the misjoinder of causes, counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the present petition so as to enable his client to file separate fresh writ petitions.

Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
