Learned counsel for respondent No. 3/Insurance Company has offered to grant ₹ 2,10,000/- over and above the amount granted by learned M.A.C.T., Jagadhri. This amount is acceptable to the appellant(s) as full and final settlement. Statements of appellant No. 1 on behalf of himself and appellant No. 2 being his father and learned counsel for the respondent No. 3 to this effect have been recorded separately.

In view of the above amicable settlement between the parties, we direct respondent No. 3 to deposit cheque or demand draft for ₹ 2,10,000/- lakh in the name of appellant No. 1-Paramjeet Singh (for both appellants) with the Office of Lok Adalat of the High Court within six weeks from today and the same be handed over to the appellant against proper receipt and identification, failing which, the amount would carry interest at the rate of 9% per annum from the date of settlement till its realization.
