The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the official respondents to comply with order dated 14.11.2017 (Anneuxre P-1) passed by this Court in CWP No.25222 of 2015.

Earlier also, the petitioners filed CWP No.25222 of 2015, which was disposed of vide order dated 14.11.2017 with the direction to the petitioners to appear before respondent No.1 within a period of two weeks from the date of passing of the order and respondent No.1 was directed to hear their grievance and take an appropriate decision.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that no action has been taken, whereas the petitioners appeared before respondent No.1 on 01.12.2017.

In the earlier writ petition, direction is already there. No separate direction is required to be issued. However, the petitioners are having a remedy of contempt but instead of filing contempt petition, the present writ petition has been filed.

Keeping in view the interest of justice and just to avoid the multiplicity of litigation, the respondents are directed to take action in view of order passed on 14.11.2017 in CWP No.25222 of 2015 within a period of two weeks, failing which the contempt proceedings will be initiated.

Disposed of accordingly.
