The petitioner alleges rampant unauthorized mining.

If that be so then we are of the opinion that it is an issue to be raised in public interest for which the petitioner would be at liberty to file an appropriate writ petition by styling it so.

The second grievance raised before us is of petitioner's land is being damaged because of the excessive mining. It has been stated before us that land of the petitioner has been repeatedly encroached upon. We are of the opinion that this would be an issue to be raised before Civil Court which is better equipped to deal with the issue which requires evidence in view of the conflicting factual situation that may emerge. We, therefore, decline interference in the present petition but dispose it of with liberty to the

petitioner to avail himself of any other alternate remedy available to him in law.
