The petitioners, by way of present writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, are seeking writ of mandamus directing the respondents to grant the petitioners reasonable time to vacate their residential houses in terms of settlement dated 18.05.2015 (Annexure P-2). They have also prayed for issuance of writ of mandamus directing the respondents to immediately release the full compensation awarded to them in terms of the settlement. A further prayer has been made to set aside the impugned eviction notice dated 15.03.2018 (Annexure P-6), to complete the development works and to remove high tension wires running over the allotted plots or issue any other appropriate writ, order or direction which this Court may deem proper.

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2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners, states that he may be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to approach the authorities concerned by making a representation to them.

3. The petition is dismissed as withdrawn.

4. It shall, however, be open to the petitioners to take recourse to the remedies, as may be available to them, in accordance with law.
