The grievance of the petitioners in the present petition is that there was a litigation between them as in the suit, they were plaintiff and defendants. At the stage of Regular Second Appeal, both the parties compromised the dispute between them. After recording the statements of the parties, the Regular Second Appeal was disposed of vide order dated 19.12.2013. It was also mentioned that the parties shall be bound by the terms and conditions of the compromise and the same shall form part of the decree. Petitioners requested respondent No.3 for mutation but no action has been taken. Orally, it has been stated that respondent No.3 was not a party to the compromise.

Learned counsel also submits that not only the representation was made by the petitioners but a legal notice was also served upon the respondents but no action has been taken thereupon so far. He further submits that the petitioners would be satisfied, in case, the directions are issued to take action on the legal notice dated 17.02.2017 (Annexure P-5)

within some stipulated period.

Keeping in view the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioners and after considering the compromise arrived at between them, who are the petitioners in the present petition, respondent Nos.2 and 3 are directed to take action on the legal notice dated 17.02.2017 (Annexure P-5) within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

However, in case, the petitioners are required to be heard in person, the opportunity be given to them, if necessary. The necessary exercise be done after considering the compromise arrived at between the parties.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
