Through the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to release the pension and other pensionary benefits to her along with interest @ 12% per annum.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that husband of the petitioner was taken away by the nature on 20.07.2017. Subsequent thereto for seeking family pension and other pensionary benefits, petitioner served a representation to the respondent No.1 on 31.07.2017 (P-4) but till date no conscious decision has been taken. He further submits that she feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents to decide her representation (P-4) within some specified period.

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3. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents particularly respondent No.3-Deputy Commissioner, Sonapat to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the representation dated 31.07.2017 (P-4) and take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order as per rules, regulations and instructions issued by the Government from time to time, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case of passing an adverse order or rejection of this claim putforth by the petitioner, she shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
