In the nature of order I propose to pass, no formal written statement(s)/counter-affidavit(s) on behalf of the respondents are indeed necessary at this stage. Thus, with the consent of the learned counsel for the parties, the petition is being disposed of finally.

The petitioner prays for a direction to the respondents to consider his claim for awarding him the State Teachers' Award, 2017, for not only the petitioner is fully eligible therefor, but possess better qualification and credentials than those who have since been awarded the said Award. The petitioner purports to have repeatedly represented to the respondents in this regard. But to no avail. Even the legal notice, dated 16.1.2018 (Annexure P-5), the respondents have been served with, has failed to evoke any response.

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In response, learned counsel for the respondents submits that claim/grievance of the petitioner as also his legal notice, dated 16.1.2018 (Annexure P-5), shall be considered and decided within a period of four weeks from today. And appropriate orders, in accordance with law, shall be passed and communicated to the petitioner.

The petition is accordingly disposed of, in the above terms. In the event, the claim of the petitioner is declined, the authority shall pass a comprehensive order assigning reasons in support thereof.
