Rekha Mittal, J.

The claimants are in appeal seeking enhancement of compensation on account of death of Rakesh Kumar in a motor vehicular accident that took place on 6.7.2010.

The Motor Accidents Claims Tribunal, Karnal (in short “the Tribunal”) has awarded compensation of Rs. 4,84, 506/- rounded off to Rs. 4,85,000/- in view of the structured formula provided in 2nd Schedule appended to Section 163-A of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (in short “the Act”) as the application was filed by the claimants under Section 163-A of the Act.

I have gone through the award particularly findings of the tribunal in para 20 thereof but find no justification for interference in assessment made by the Tribunal when the case is examined in the light of

structured formula laid down in the 2nd schedule.

For the foregoing reasons, finding no merit, the appeal fails and
is accordingly dismissed in limine.
