1. The petitioners, by way of present writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, are seeking a writ of mandamus directing the respondent-authorities to allot the petitioners alternate plots of lands as per the Final Terms of the settlement dated 18.05.2015 (Annexure P-1). Further prayer has also been made to set aside the notice of eviction and demolition (Annexure P-4), of the petitioners' houses and only after the handing over of the possession of the alternate plots, that they be evicted from their residential houses in terms of the settlement (Annexure P-1).

2 After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners states that he may be allowed to withdraw the present

petition with liberty to the petitioners to approach the authorities concerned by making a representation to them, in accordance with law.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn.
4. It shall, however, be open to the petitioners to take recourse to the remedies, as may be available to them, in accordance with law.
