In the instant writ petition, petitioner has challenged communication dated 7.6.2017 (Annexure P-1) by which disciplinary action taken against the petitioner and its file has been transmitted from the office of District & Sessions Judge, Faridabad to District & Sessions Judge, Bhiwani.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that on an earlier occasion, petitioner's request was turned down on 7.11.2016 with reference to decision of the Hon'ble Chief Justice. Undisputed facts are that disciplinary authority in respect of petitioner as on 7.6.2017 is District & Sessions Judge, Bhiwani. If the initiation of inquiry against petitioner was when he was working at Faridabad and during pendency of the disciplinary proceedings petitioner's services have been transferred from one District to another District. In that event it is necessary to transmit the disciplinary

proceedings records to the concerned District & Sessions Judge. Insofar as petitioner is concerned, the District and Sessions Judge, Bhiwani would be disciplinary authority. Therefore, there is no infirmity in the communication dated 7.06.2017 (Annexure P-1).

Accordingly, petition stands dismissed.
