By virtue of the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to count the length of service rendered by her i.e. 20 years & 5 months instead of 14 years & 06 months calculated on the last pay drawn towards the pension calculated by the University College, Kurukshetra on the pro-rata basis.

2. At the very outset of the arguments, petitioner stood retired on 31.10.2004 on attaining the age of superannuation. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though a representation was made to the respondents on 13.01.2018 (P-10) but till date no action has been taken so far. He further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to

respondent No.4 to decide the aforesaid representation (P-10) in a time bound manner.

3. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4-The Registrar, Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra to consider the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the representation dated 13.01.2018 (P-10) and take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order as per rules, regulations and instructions issued by the Government from time to time, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the aforesaid authority, she shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
