Application is allowed as prayed for.

Main Case

By virtue of the instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the direction to the respondents for taking into consideration the services rendered by him as SPO for the purpose of grant of seniority, fixation of pay and other consequential benefits as well as release of arrears of pay and refixation of his pay w.e.f. 27.09.1993 along with interest @ 12% per annum.

2. At the very outset of the arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the connected matters have already been dealt with

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and disposed of by the Coordinate Bench of this Court while passing CWP No.8549 of 2018 captioned as ***Satwinder Singh & Ors. vs. State of Punjab & ors.***, decided on 05.04.2018, whereby a direction is issued to the respondents to consider and dispose of the matter in a time bound manner and instant petition be disposed of in terms thereof. He further submits that present petition be treated as a representation on behalf of the petitioner.

3. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 – Director General of Police, Punjab, Punjab Police Head Quarter, Sector 9, Chandigarh to consider the claim of the petitioner has set up in the aforesaid writ/representation, in light of the rules, regulations as well as orders passed in the cases of similarly situated employees/pensioners, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case, petitioner still feels aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the aforesaid authority, he shall be at liberty to have recourse to the other remedies available under law as well as to approach this Court.
