1. Prima facie juniors persons working in the capacity of Peons, Sweeper-cum-Chowkidars, Water Carriers etc in Class-IV have been regularized in service w.e.f. 01.04.2011 as per prevailing policy, whereas the services of the petitioners has been regularized in the year 2014. This disparity has led to the filing of this petition seeking equal treatment and equality before the law.

2. If the statement of the petitioners is the correct factual position and there is rational and reasonable classification, then it would more appropriate to direct respondent No.2 in the first instance to consider the decide the legal notice dated 22.01.2018 and convey the decision thereon to the petitioners. If the claim is justified then a speaking order would not be required to be passed. If it is otherwise, the 2nd respondent would have to hear the petitioners and pass a reasoned order within two months from the date of the receiving the certified

copy of the order or from the date of its presentation before the competent authority, whichever is earlier.

3. With these observations and directions, the petition is disposed of.
